

Elkton Area United Services (EAUS), a comprehensive social service agency serving eastern Rockingham County since 1972, provides assistance with housing, electricity, heat, food, GED classes, school supplies, books, transportation, aid to stranded travelers, senior citizen activities, and a joyful holiday season to those in need. EAUS strives to develop programs where a need exists and aims to meet the needs of an ever-changing community. The organization is supported primarily through community donations, thrift store proceeds, and a United Way of Harrisonburg and Rockingham County Community Impact grant.

United

EAUS's programs include:

Emergency assistance

aid to families or individuals who are in immediate financial need. These needs include funding for housing, fuel, electricity and medical needs, within reason. Applicants must meet federally mandated income guidelines to qualify.

Food pantry

to help area families stretch their food dollars. Food is distributed every Tuesday and the third Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of each month. Nutrition classes are also conducted at the food pantry. The food pantry is located at 412 Gibbons Ave. in Elkton.

Meals on Wheels

provides nutritious meals for homebound Elkton area residents each Thursday. There are no specific eligibility requirements other than a "need" must be present. No special preparations are made for persons on restricted diets.

Holiday cheer

is coordinated with area churches, organizations and businesses to provide a joyful holiday season for older adults and families with children.

Senior citizens

meet every other Tuesday at the Elkton Community Center for bingo. This program is conducted in partnership with the Elkton Recreation Department.





Literacy

in the community is provided through several programs:

• GED classes

are taught each Monday and Wednesday evening during the school year by Massanutten Technical Center.

Stock the Rock

school supply drive gives school supplies to children at Elkton Elementary School, McGaheysville Elementary School, River Bend Elementary School, Elkton Middle School and East Rockingham High School.

• Reading Rules!

gives free books to school-age children.

Women, Infants & Children (WIC)

appointments are available three times a month at the Client Services office, 187 W. Spotswood Ave.

Traveler's aid

helps individuals traveling through the Elkton area who are in need of assistance.

Employment application

assistance is available through Client Services.

Dental assistance

is available, within reason. Applicants must meet federally mandated income guidelines in order to qualify.
